Format of Contest:

1. Question & Answer Session (50%)
 - Participants will answer questions on the following disciplines: English, Chinese, Math, Science, Social or general knowledge about Canada.
 - Samples of questions will be uploaded on the website of VCLC and VSSE.
2. Talent Performance (50%)
 - Each participant will be given not more than 5 minutes to perform his or her talent on the stage. Performances may be singing, dancing, playing of musical instruments, recitation of poems, telling jokes and stories etc. The performance of talent must be pre-approved by the organizers.
 - The organizers have the final authority to decline any registration due to the shortage of manpower, facilities and technical support.
3. The decision of the judges will be final and no appeal will be accepted.

1. Junior Group (Gr. 1 to Gr. 4 Students)
2. Intermediate Group (Gr. 5 to Gr. 7 Students)
3. Senior Group (Secondary Students)
