

## Form 1

### SOCIETY ACT CONSTITUTION

1. The name of the Society is **VANCOUVER SOWERS SOCIETY EDUCATION**.
  
2. The purposes of the Society are:
  - a) To improve the foundation education in improvised countries and regions.
  - b) To purchase, exchange, or lease land and / or buildings for educational programs for children.
  - c) To construct schools or education centres, and to enforce structure, environment, facilities, equipment, garden, field, and supporting services for children.
  - d) To establish library, printing, publication and distribution of books, periodicals, and pamphlets for children.
  - e) To cooperate or by joint venture with other education organizations, community centres or governments to promote education programs for children.
  - f) To grant scholarships to students for their advancement.
  - g) To donate funds to other “qualified donees” allowed under the “*Income Tax Act*”, which have purposes similar to the Society.

3. The activities of the Society shall be carried on without purpose of gain for its members and any income, profits or other accretions to the Society shall be used in promoting the purposes of the Society.
  
4. Upon the winding-up or dissolution of the Society, the funds and property remaining after the payment of all costs, charges and expenses properly incurred in the winding-up or dissolution, including the remuneration of a liquidator, and after payment to employees of the Society of any arrears of salaries or wages, and after payment of any

debts of the Society, shall be distributed to such charities, registered under the provisions of the *Income Tax Act*, or such “qualified donees” allowed under the *Income Tax Act*, as shall be designated by the board of the Society. Any of such funds or property remaining which had originally been received for specific purposes shall, wherever possible, be distributed to “qualified donees” or charities registered under the provisions of the *Income Tax Act* carrying on work of a similar nature to such specific purposes.

5. Paragraphs 3, 4 and 5 are unalterable.

## **Appendix – Original Constitution**

2. The objects of the Society are:

- a) To raise funding and to accept gifts of any kind from governments, foundations, private and public associations and individuals.
- b) To purchase, exchange or lease land and / or buildings for educational programs for children.
- c) To construct schools or education centres and to enforce structure, environment, facilities, equipment, garden, garden, field and supporting services for children.
- d) To establish library, printing, publication and distribution of books, periodicals and pamphlets for children.
- e) To co-operate or by joint ventures with other educational organizations, community centres or governments to promote education programs for children.
- f) To promote, advance, aid and assist in education for children of any race, and anywhere in the world.
- g) To grant scholarships to students for their advancement.
- h) To set up programs for exchange teachers among nations to promote understanding and co-operation of different cultures.
- i) To donate funds to other educational activities for their buildings, classes or equipment for the summer camps of special needy students and for students' field trips to visit other lands.
